Public hearing called to order by R. McCoy at 6:00 p.m.

LONG ISLAND CT. DREDGING SPECIAL ASSESSMENT PROJECT PUBLIC HEARING No. 2

Public Present: 16 people signed in

Supervisor McCoy opened the Public Hearing with a short presentation of the proposed assessment roll. Copies of the proposed roll were handed out to the public.

Comments/questions from the public:

One letter received:

Chateau Park Niagara Inc., June 3, 2011 - (capsulated) protesting any special assessment against the property; *the dredging as proposed is of no benefit to the property; no objection to the dredging for the mutual benefit of the community.*

Question on how many property owners signed the petition? *Over 51%*

Question about why the Board is doing the SAD by lot vs. footage? *Supervisor McCoy explained the SAD and the figures; it is most equitable to do the district by lot.*

Concern about paying interest when permits have not yet been obtained to date.

Question on liability? *The contractor shall have insurance for the project once the Board finalizes the assessment roll.*

Question if decision to remove debris down Alexandria Drive and Swan River has been resolved? *Yes, these roads will not be used.*

Question if the County and the Township are going to pick up the cost on the water Works Drive side of the canal? *No, neither the Township nor the County have a benefit to the proposed dredging.*

No further questions or comments from the public. Public hearing for Long Island Ct. dredging special assessment project closed at 6:33 p.m.
